GENERAL INFORMATION ON PUBLIC HEALTH

The following additional Public Health precautions are planned for the meeting in addition to the Event Health and Safety Management Plan.

The 2021 Sir Graeme Douglas International is being held at the Douglas Track & Field Stadium under Alert Level 1 Conditions.

General:

- ✓ Please stay home and avoid attending if you are:
 - Unwell
 - o A confirmed or probable case of COVID-19
 - Waiting for a COVID-19 test result
 - Self-isolating

Stadium Entry:

- ✓ All attendees (athletes, officials, spectators, etc...) will be requested to SCAN the QR code on arrival at the Gate or register on the registration file.
- ✓ The QR code will also be published on the back of the Official Programme.
- ✓ All entry points and competition zones will have Hand sanitizer available.

General Stadium Protocols

- ✓ Athletes and officials will be reminded about physical distancing where necessary and possible in their competitions zones.
- ✓ Food sales are contactless by Public vendors.

Meet Accommodation

- ✓ All athletes and officials staying at the Quality Hotel Lincoln Green are expected to observe the Hotel COVID **19** Protocols including scanning in with QR code and any specific Hotel instructions.
- ✓ Athletes will be asked to wear masks while travelling on public transport.
